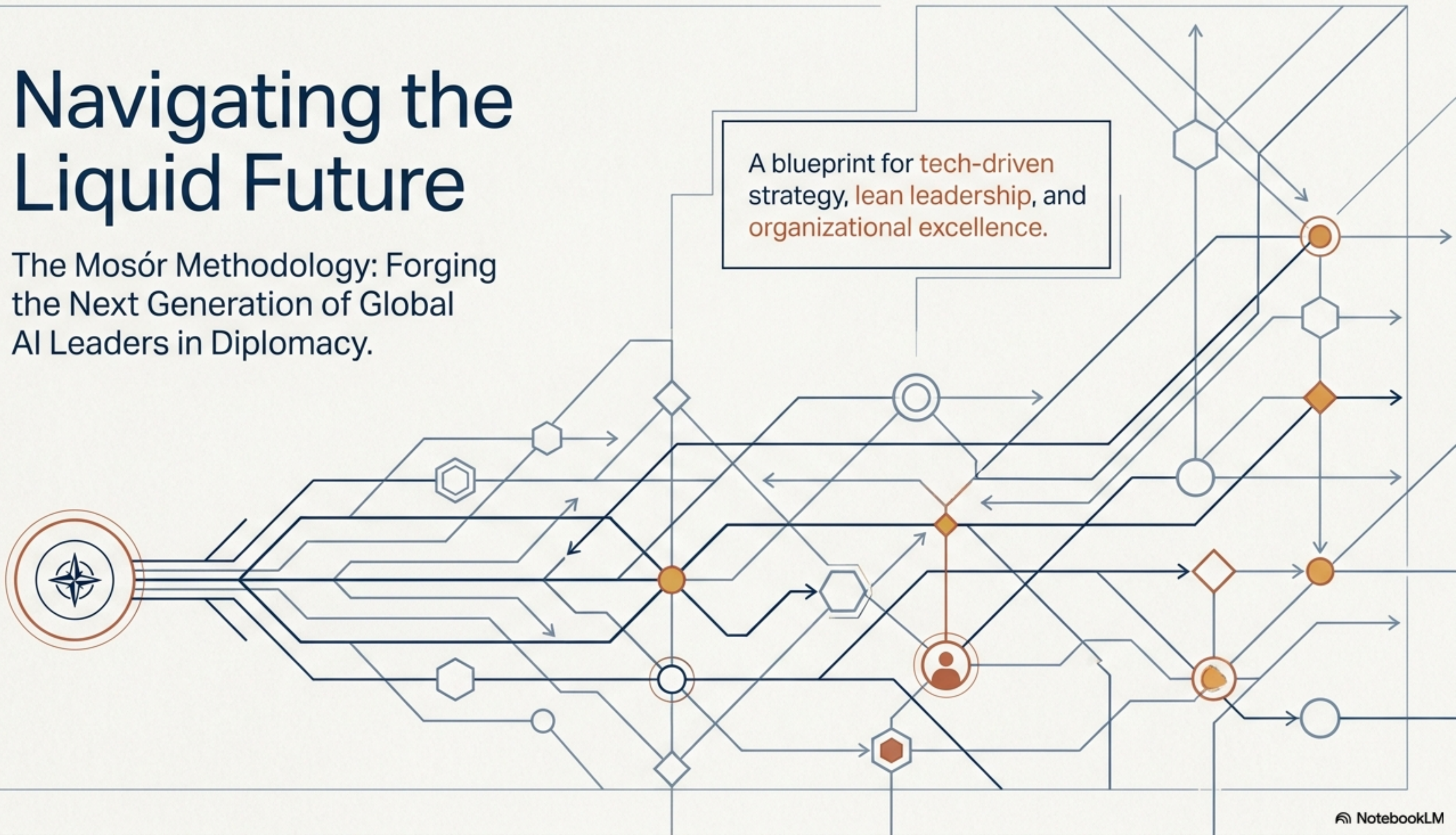

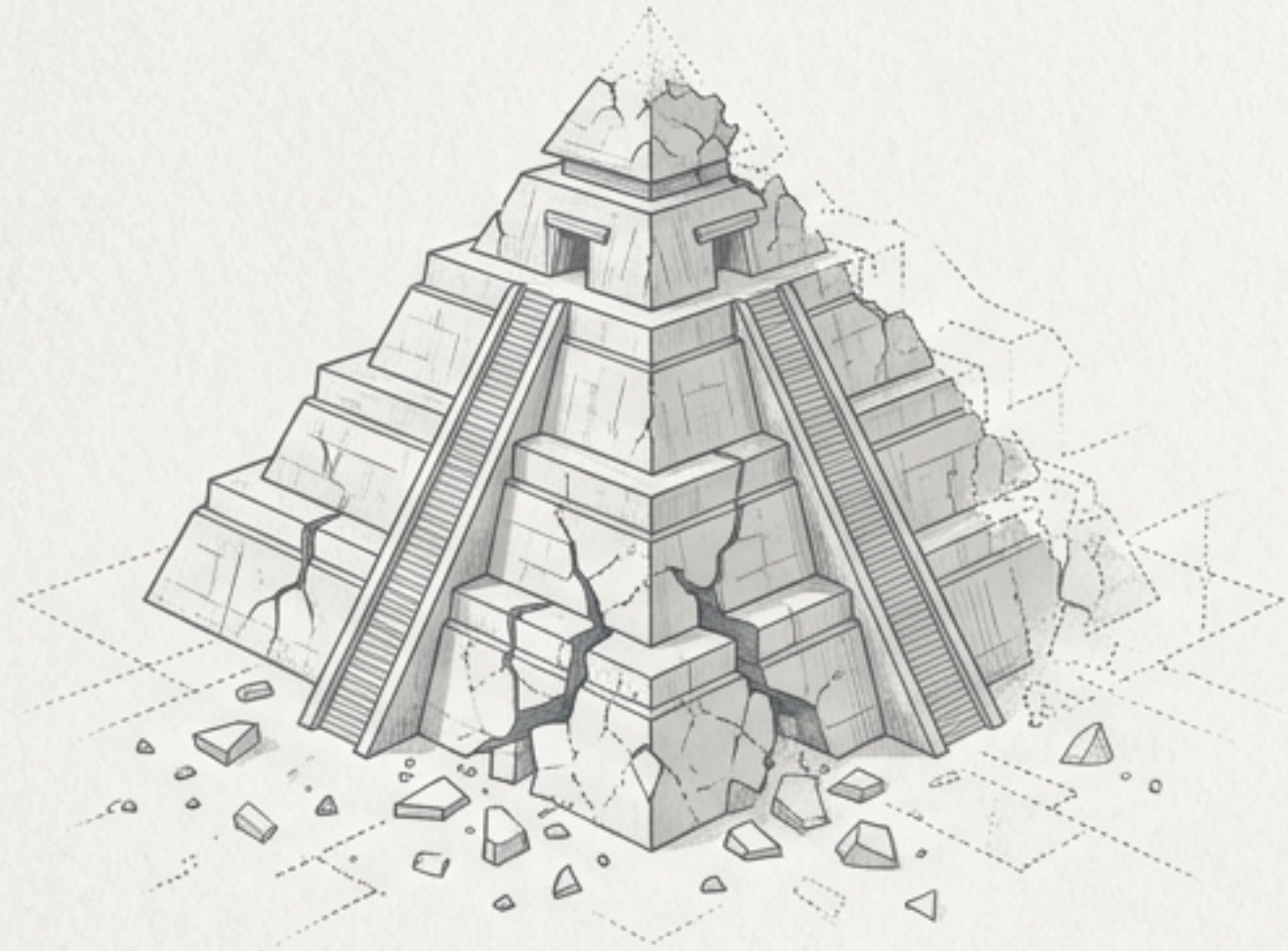

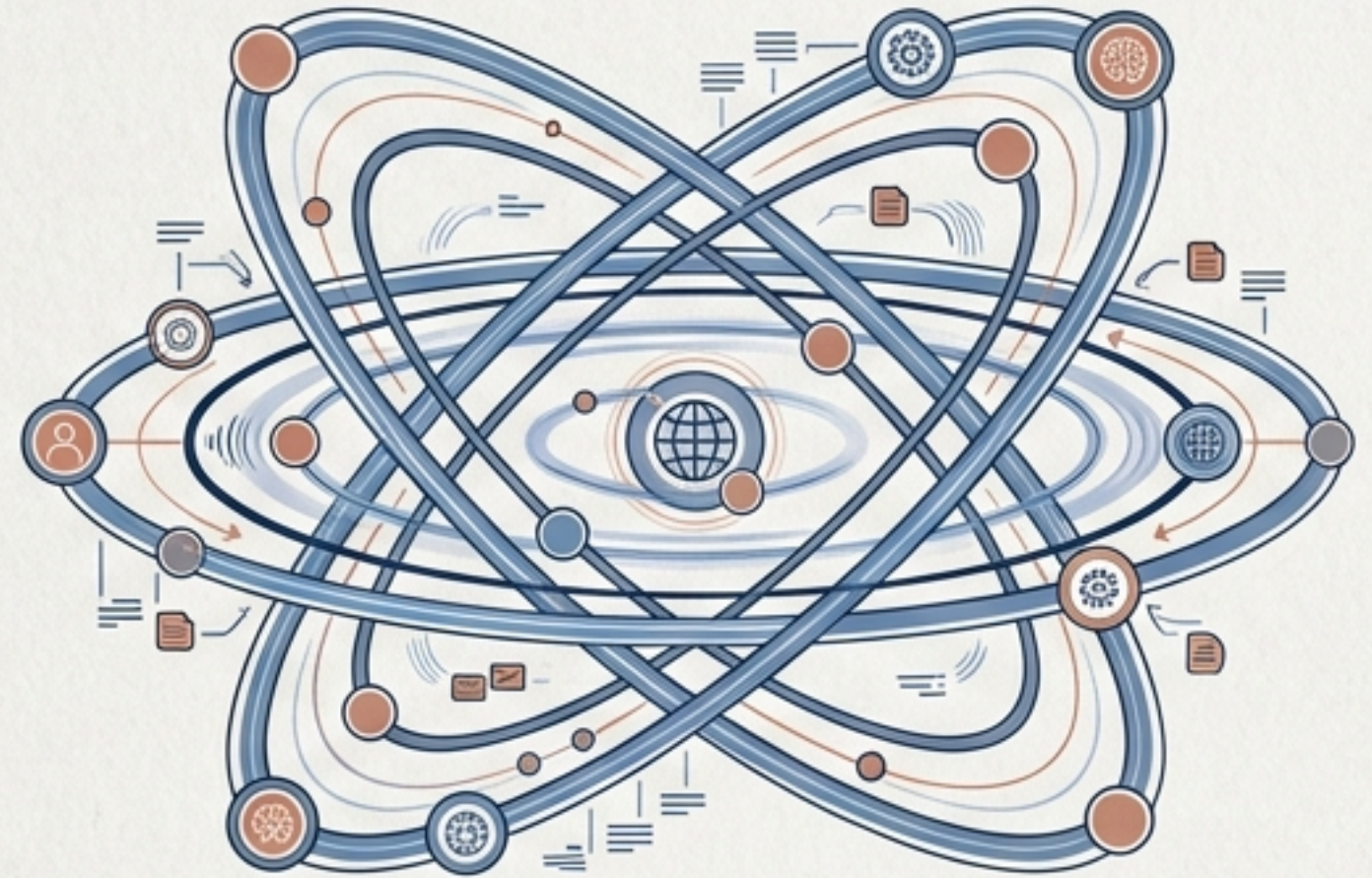
20th-Century Hierarchies are Dissolving into the AI Economy

The Paradigm Shift



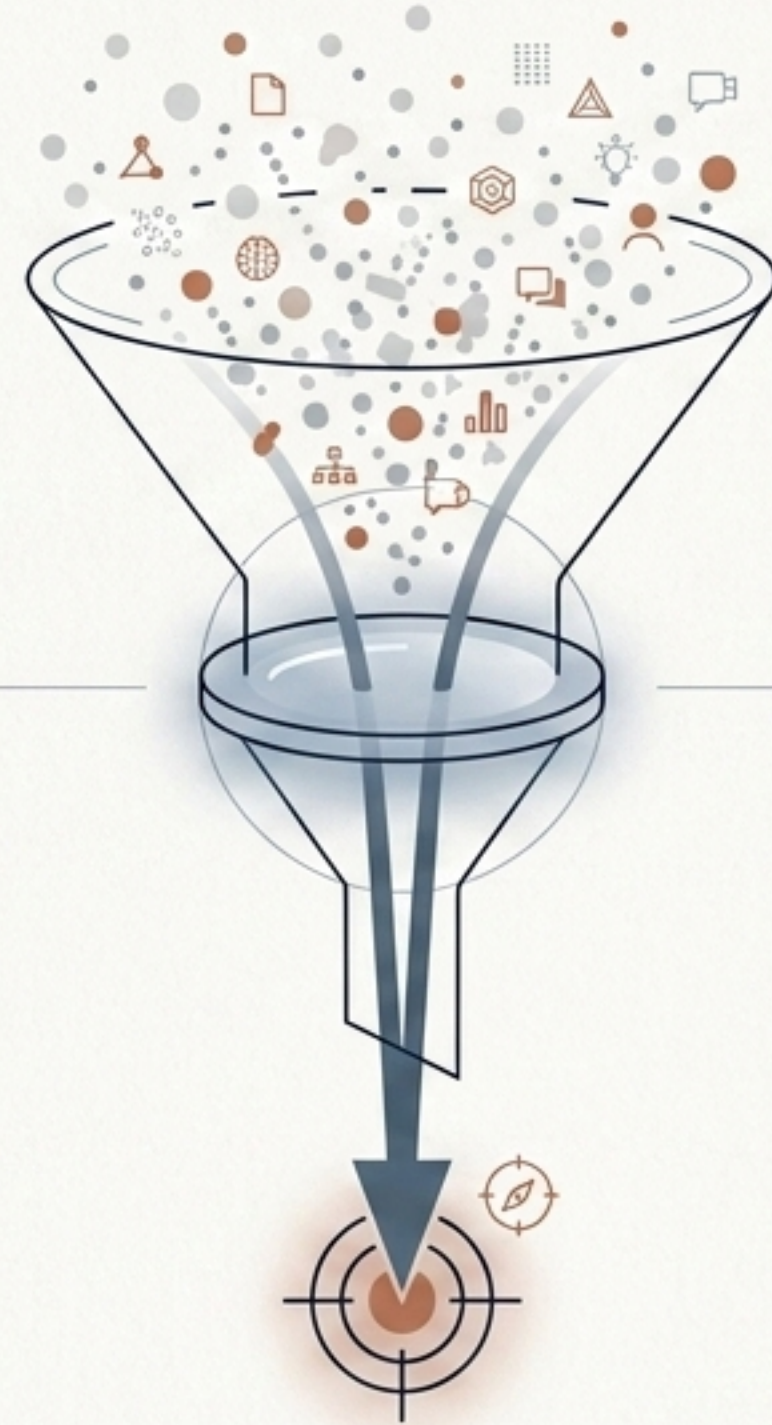
We have entered the Liquid Future. A diplomat is no longer merely a representative of a static state entity, but a strategic node operating within a dynamic, decentralized global network.

To support the development of **1 million AI leaders** who master tech-driven global strategy.

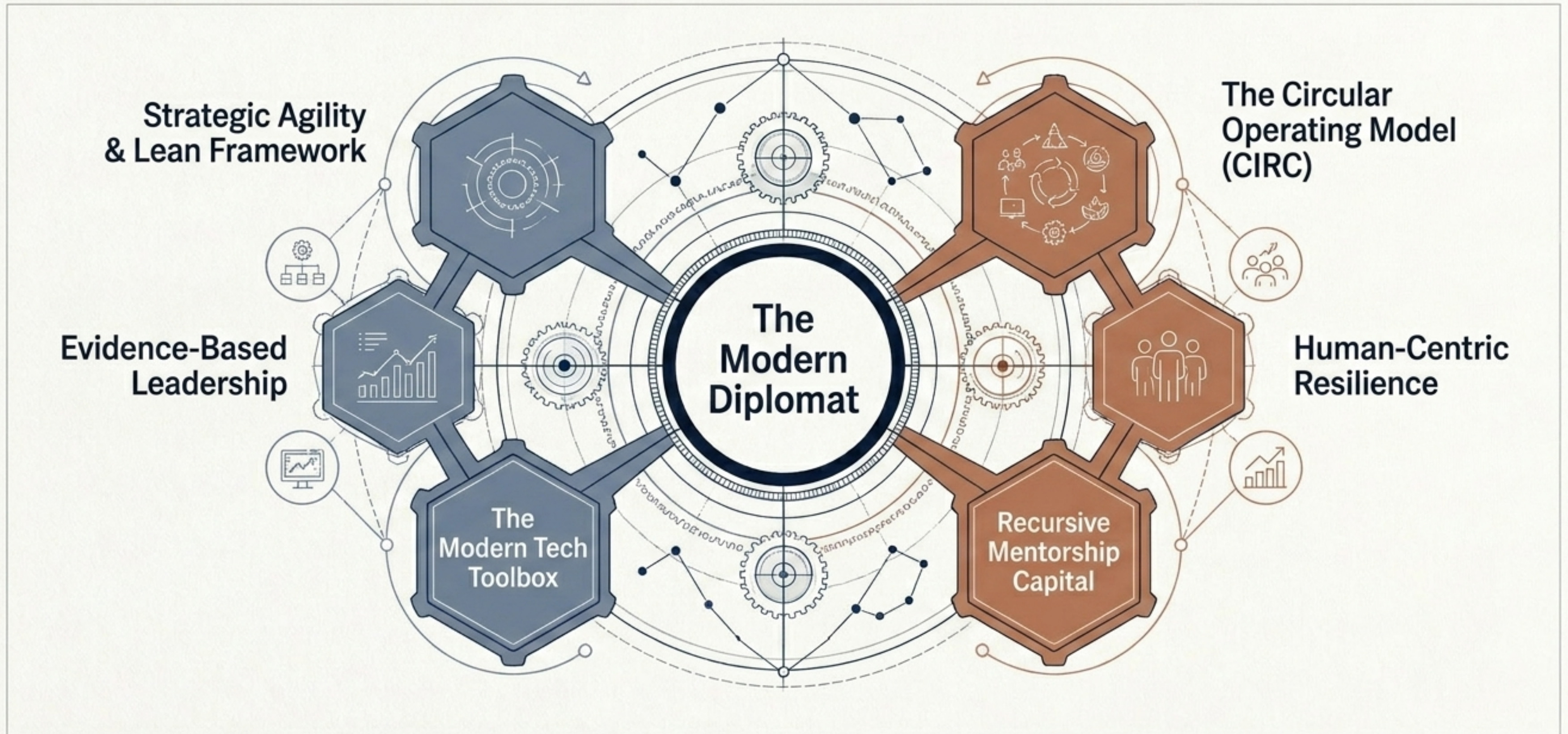
The Trap

Attempting to be “good at everything.” In modern diplomacy, generalists are easily replaced by AI.

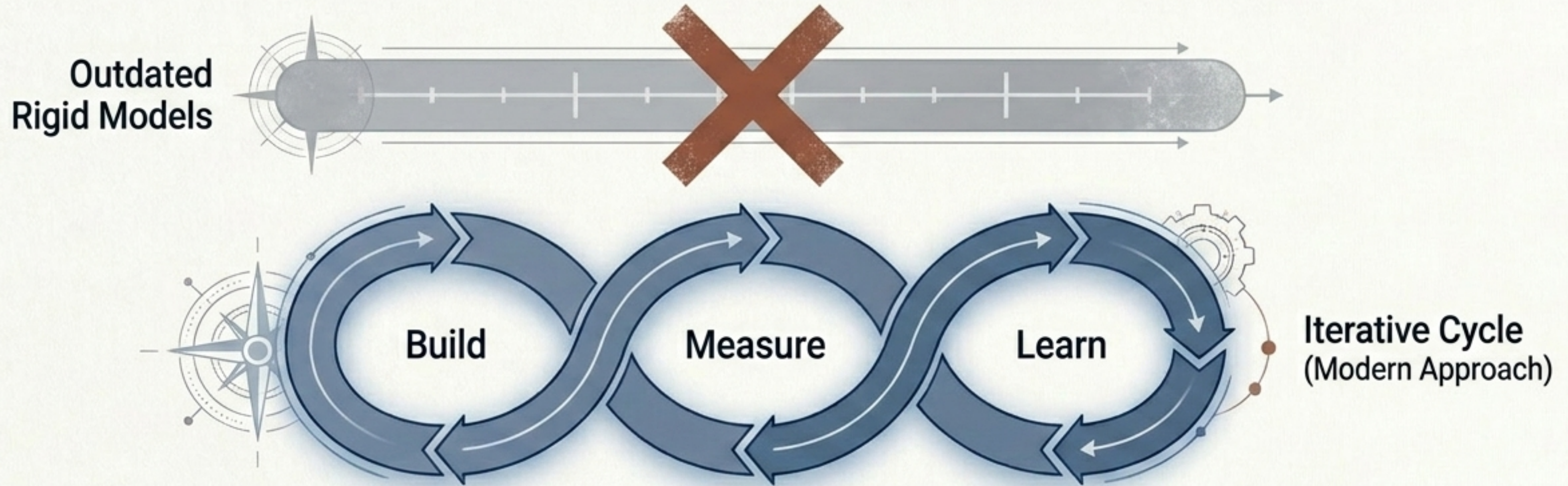
The Mandate

The Mosór Methodology: Six Pillars of Leadership



Pillar I: Treat Policy as Iterative Experimentation



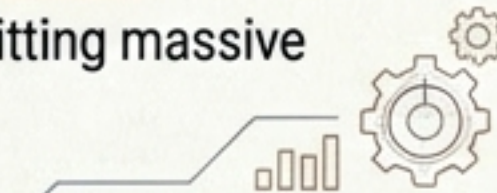
Lean Strategy

Abandon rigid, unchangeable policies that become obsolete before implementation.



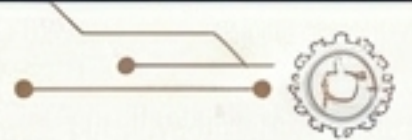
The Minimum Viable Policy (MVP)

Deploy the smallest possible diplomatic action to generate feedback and validate assumptions before committing massive state resources.



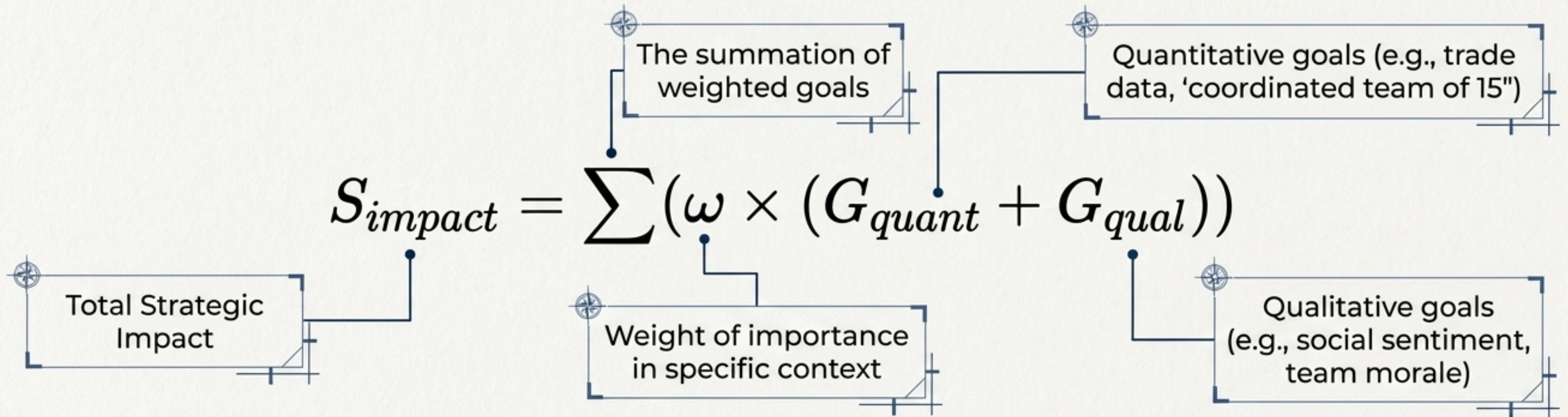
Agile Leadership

Shift to "no-management" principles. Act as a facilitator using iterative sprints, radical transparency, and continuous feedback to adapt to overnight geopolitical shifts.



Pillar II: Evidence-Based Leadership Counteracts Instability

Credibility is built on facts, not adjectives.



Takeaway: In unstable environments, measuring concrete reality provides internal stability, agency, and collective resilience for the team.

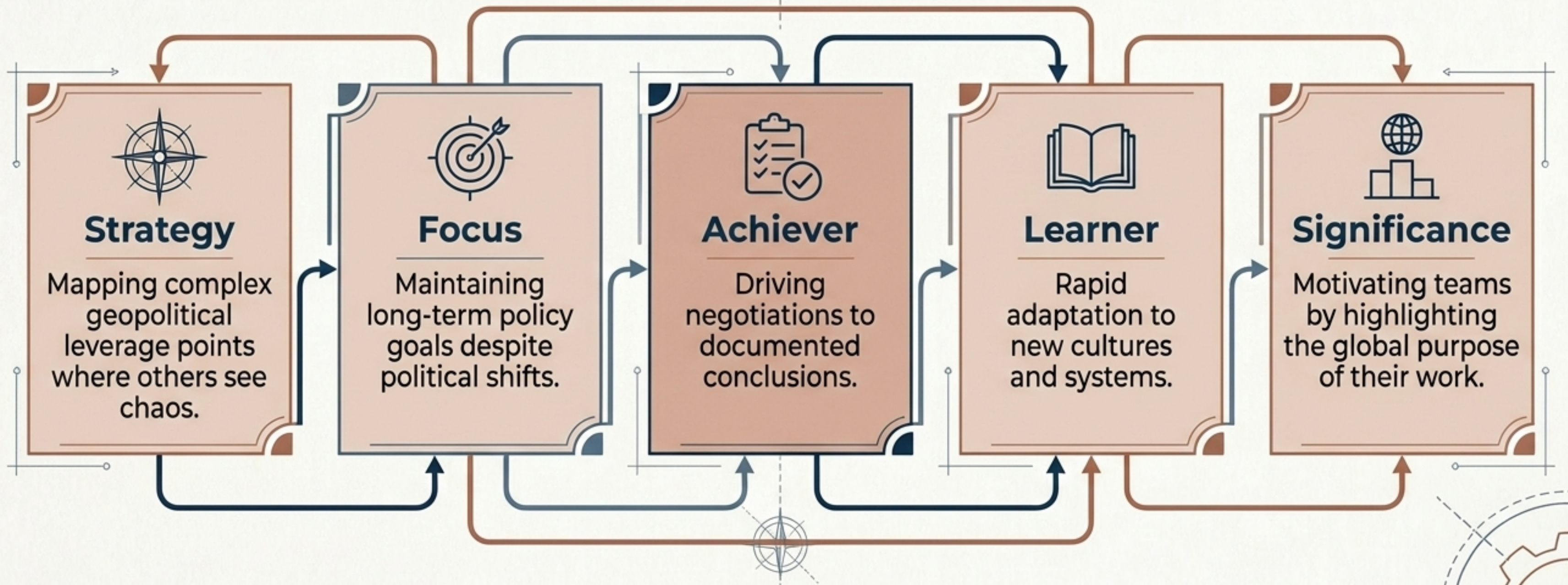
Pillar III: The Circular Operating Model (CIRC)

Context: Linear, sprawling bureaucracies bleed resources and capital. CIRC is an AI-based framework prioritizing continuous reinvestment over depletion.



Pillar IV: “Be a Leader. Be Human.”

Context: Despite the integration of AI, mission success ultimately hinges on human psychology, integrity, and resilience.



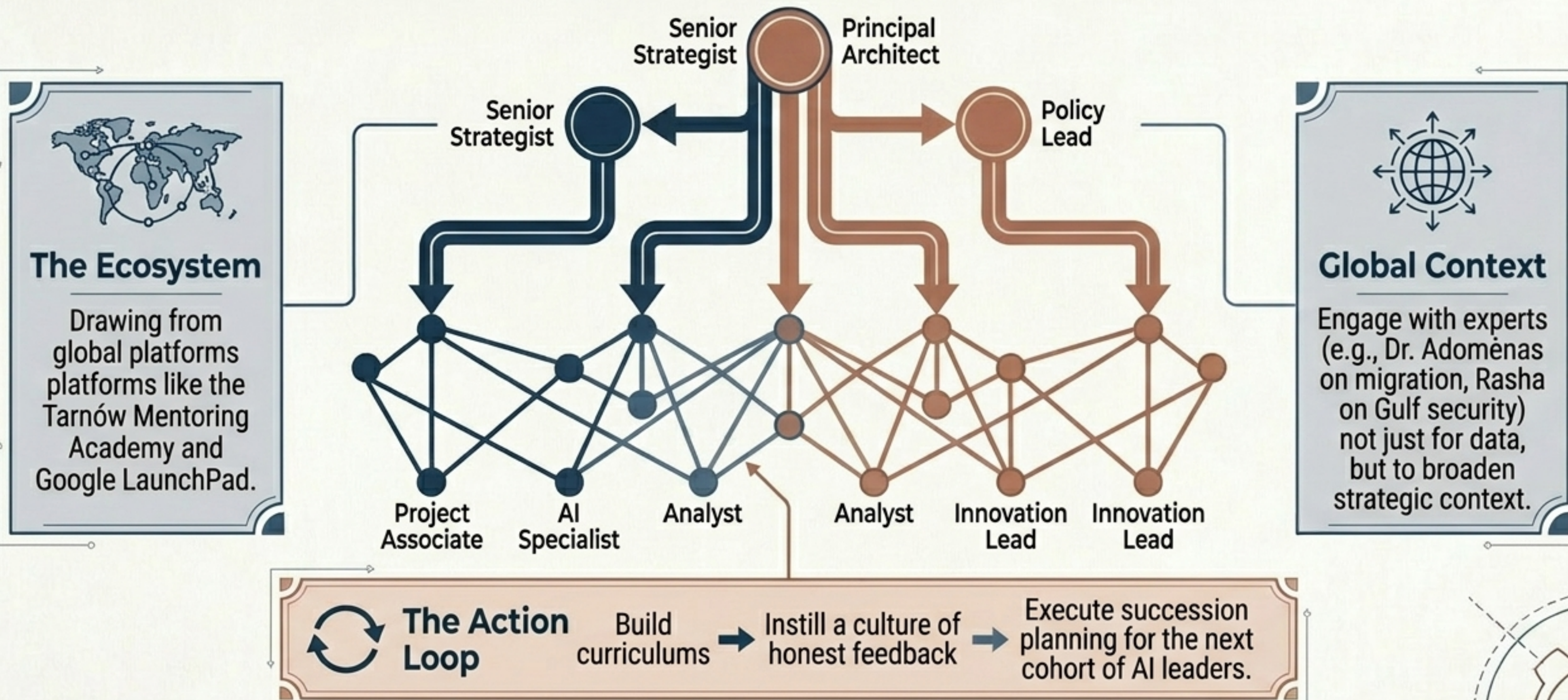
Pillar V: Technology is the New Infrastructure

The Mandate: You don't need to code, but you must understand system architecture (R, SQL, cryptography). Tech is your "second language."

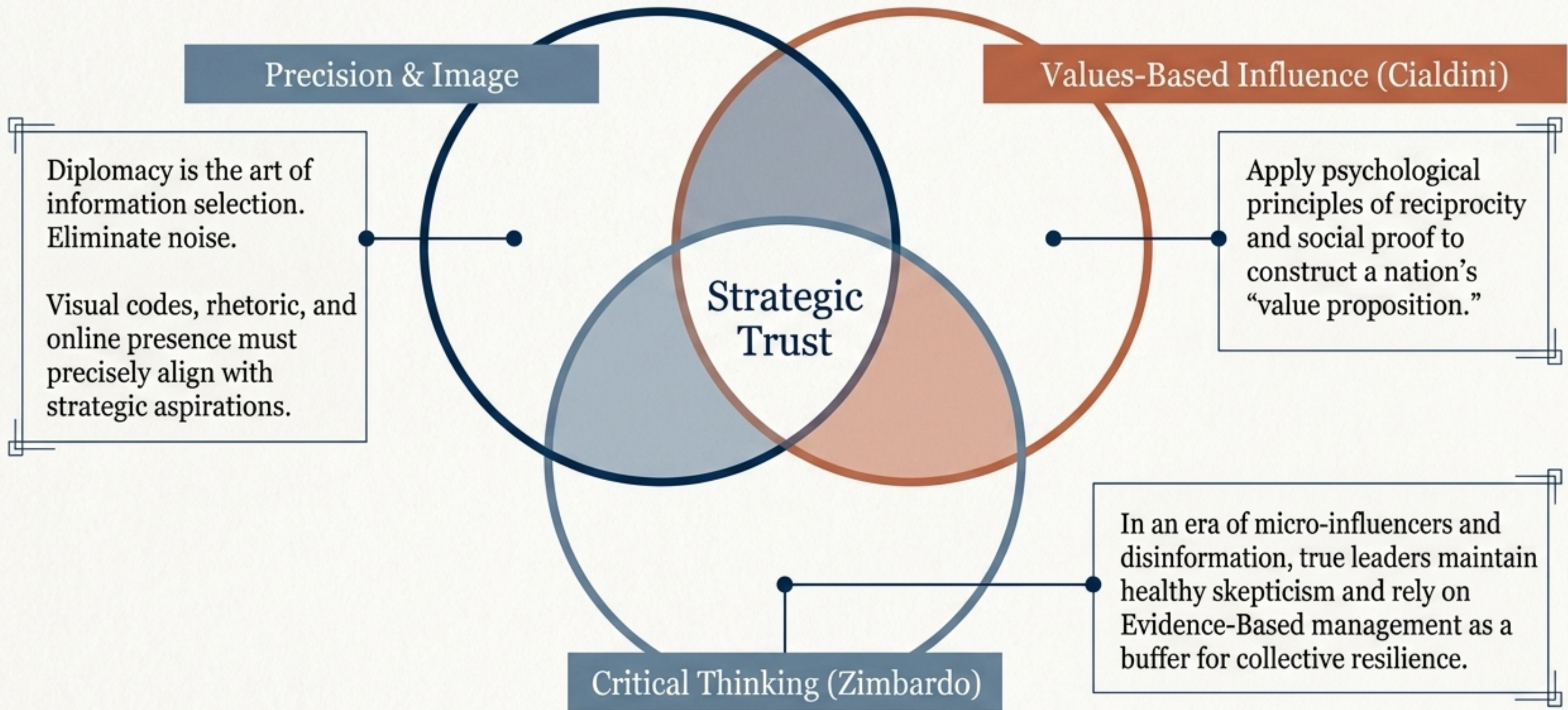


Pillar VI: Relationship Capital and Recursive Mentorship

The Philosophy: “Be the mentor you wish you had.”

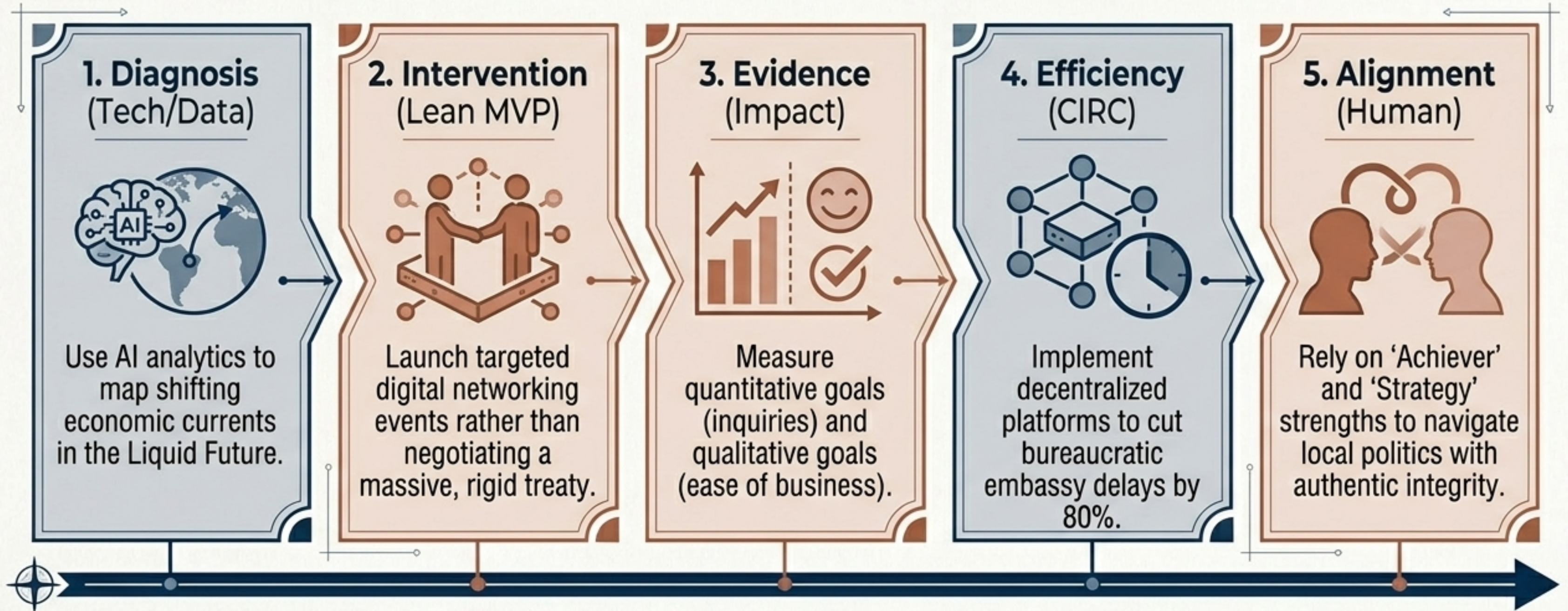
